Facility Labs

- Surgical Pathology a medical specialty focusing on the examination of tissues removed from living patients during surgery or biopsies to diagnose diseases, determine prognosis, and guide treatment plans. *example: removal of a mole*
- Urgent Care Facilities labs
- Pre-op performed on the same day in the same facility as the surgery

Office Labs

- Blood Occult (*test to check stool samples*) performed in provider's office with medical diagnosis
- Strep Test cultures, including rapid Strep Tests performed in provider's office with medical diagnosis
- Urinalysis performed in provider's office with medical diagnosis
- Urine Pregnancy test performed in provider's office
- Hemoglobin; glycated without a blood draw measures the protein in red blood cells that carries oxygen, primarily used to detect [anemia](#) (low levels) or [polycythemia](#) (high levels).
 - If a blood draw is done, must be sent to a LabCorp or Quest
- Prothrombin time a blood test that measures how many seconds it takes for the liquid portion (plasma) of blood to clot. this test is not sent out, performed in provider's office with medical diagnosis

Routine Labs under ACA Guidelines

- Routine Labs
- Pap Smear
- PSA (Prostate-Specific Antigen) blood test measures the level of a protein produced by the prostate gland to help screen for cancer monitor, or detect [noncancerous conditions](#) like infections or enlargement.

Home Healthcare Labs

Port Catheter Labs

End Stage Renal Disease Patients (*blood count test to determine the length of dialysis*)

Chemotherapy, Radiation or Blood Transfusions – blood work performed same day

Blood glucose testing, reagent strip for diabetes *example: if no blood drawn, only finger stick, blood is reviewed in office*
