I. CALL TO ORDER

A quorum being present, the Chairman called the meeting to order.

II. MINUTES

The Trustees reviewed the minutes of the last regular meeting held on June 10, 2022, and the Appeals Committee meetings held on May 17, 2022 and June 29, 2022, all of which were pre-circulated.

On Motion made and seconded, the Trustees voted unanimous approval of the following resolution:

RESOLVED that the minutes of the regular meeting held on June 10, 2022, and the Appeals Committee meetings held on May 17, 2022 and June 29, 2022, are approved, as presented.

III. FINANCIAL REPORT

A. PNC Bank

Summary of Cash Activity Report – June 30, 2022

Ms. Sims presented the Summary of Cash Activity Report for the period January 1, 2022 to June 30, 2022, as provided by PNC. Such report indicated a beginning balance of \$44,736,757, receipts of \$1,306,467,459, disbursements of \$74,327,357, and a loss on investments of \$1,891,856, resulting in a balance of \$1,274,985,003 as of June 30, 2022.

B. Investment Performance Services

The Trustees welcomed Mr. Chris McDonough of Investment Performance Services (“IPS”) to the meeting.

1. Master Consulting Report – June 30, 2022

Mr. McDonough reviewed the IPS report for the period ending June 30, 2022. Such report indicated a beginning market value of \$91,926,567, net cash flow of \$1,196,479,641, and a net investment loss of \$2,599,726, resulting in an ending market value of \$1,285,806,481 as of June 30, 2022. The performance for the second quarter was 0.1%, gross of fees.

2. Preliminary Performance Update – July 31, 2022

Mr. McDonough reviewed the IPS report for the period ending July 31, 2022. Such report indicated a beginning market value of \$91,926,567, net cash flow of \$1,188,931,596, and a net investment loss of \$966,717, resulting in an ending market value of \$1,279,891,447. The year-to-date performance through July 31, 2022 was negative 2.7%, gross of fees.

3. Short-Term Investment Strategy

Mr. McDonough presented IPS's recommended short-term strategy for investing the remaining non-SFA (legacy) assets in low risk investment grade bonds with an expected return of approximately 4%. After discussion, and

On Motion made and seconded, the Trustees voted unanimous approval of the following resolution:

RESOLVED, to approve hiring Segall Bryant Hamill as an investment grade bond manager for the Fund's non-SFA assets.

The Trustees agreed to schedule a special Board meeting for November 2, 2022 to continue discussing investment options and long-term investment strategy for the Fund's non-SFA assets.

C. Auditor's Report

The Trustees welcomed Mr. Joseph Herishen of Calibre CPA Group ("Calibre") to the meeting.

1. Financial Statements – December 31, 2021

Mr. Herishen presented the Financial Statements for the period ended December 31, 2021. He stated that the auditor's opinion was unmodified and the financial statements were in conformity with the generally accepted accounting principles.

Mr. Herishen reported that total assets as of December 31, 2021 were \$106,173,616 and total liabilities were \$267,964, producing net assets available for benefits of \$105,905,652. Mr. Herishen reviewed the Notes to the Financial Statements, Schedule of Assets Held for Investment Purposes, Schedule of Employer Contributions, and Schedule of Administrative Expenses.

On Motion made and seconded, the Trustees voted unanimous approval of the following resolution:

RESOLVED, to accept the Auditor's 2021 Financial Statements as presented.

The Trustees thanked Mr. Herishen for his report and he was excused from the meeting.

IV. ATTORNEY'S REPORT

A. Special Financial Assistance ("SFA")

B. Ms. Sanchez reported on the Fund's supplemented application for special financial assistance

from the Pension Benefit Guaranty Corporation (“PBGC”). **Final Guidance**

Ms. Sanchez reported on the final guidance issued on the American Rescue Plan Act (“ARPA”).

C. Loomis Sayles Contract and Ryan ALM Contract

Ms. Sanchez reported on the Fund’s contracts with Loomis Sayles and Ryan ALM. The Trustees requested that they be notified when these contracts are finalized and the funding of the investments has been completed.

D. Investment Managers

Ms. Sanchez reported on the contracts with the investment managers selected at the June 10, 2022 Board of Trustees meeting.

E. Voluntary Correction Program (“VCP”) Application

F. Ms. Sanchez reported on the Fund’s VCP application that was submitted to the IRS.

Department of Labor (“DOL”) Cybersecurity Best Practices

Ms. Sanchez reported on the DOL’s guidance related to cybersecurity best practices. After discussion,

On Motion made and seconded, the Trustees voted unanimous approval of the following resolution:

RESOLVED, to issue an RFP for cybersecurity consulting services.

G. ACME Contributions

Ms. Sanchez reported on Acme’s pre-withdrawal contributions to the Fund.

V. ADMINISTRATIVE MANAGER’S REPORT

A. Second Quarter 2022 Report

Ms. Sims presented the Administrative Manager’s Report for Second Quarter 2022, which had been pre-circulated. Such report indicated interest and dividend income of \$35,080, transfers from assets of \$1,303,073,639, receipt of withdrawal liability payments of \$14,188,209, and miscellaneous income of \$24,144, producing total income of \$1,317,321,072 for the quarter. Total expenses were \$37,543,042, producing a surplus of \$1,279,778,030.

Ms. Sims reviewed the pension applications contained in the Administrative Manager’s Second Quarter 2022 Report.

On Motion made and seconded, the Trustees voted unanimous approval of the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that the pension applications contained in the Administrative Manager's Second Quarter 2022 report are approved for payment.

VI. INVOICES

The Trustees reviewed the list of invoices dated September 15, 2022. It was noted there were no additions, deletions or changes to the list.

On Motion made and seconded, the Trustees voted unanimous approval of the following resolution:

RESOLVED, that the invoices on the list dated September 15, 2022 are approved for payment.

VII. OTHER FUND BUSINESS

A. Voluntary Correction Process ("VCP") Corrections

Ms. Sims reported that Associated expects to complete the corrections reflected in the Fund's VCP application by December 31, 2022.

B. PBGC Comprehensive Filing

Ms. Sims reported that the Fund office will work in conjunction with Fund Counsel to complete the PBGC Comprehensive Premium filing for the Fund.

C. Miscellaneous Correspondence

1. Federal Home Loan Corporation Settlement

Ms. Sims reported that the Fund had received a check in the amount of \$398 as a result of the Fund's claim filed in the Federal Home Loan Corporation Litigation Settlement.

2. First Solar Inc Settlement

Ms. Sims reported that the Fund had received a check in the amount of \$34 as a result of the Fund's claim filed in the First Solar Inc Litigation Settlement.

3. Seaworld Entertainment Settlement

Ms. Sims reported that the Fund had received a check in the amount of \$19,875 as a result of the Fund's claim filed in the Seaworld Entertainment Litigation Settlement.

4. Terex Corporation Settlement

Ms. Sims reported that the Fund had received a check in the amount of \$3,837 as a result of the Fund's claim filed in the Terex Corporation Litigation Settlement.

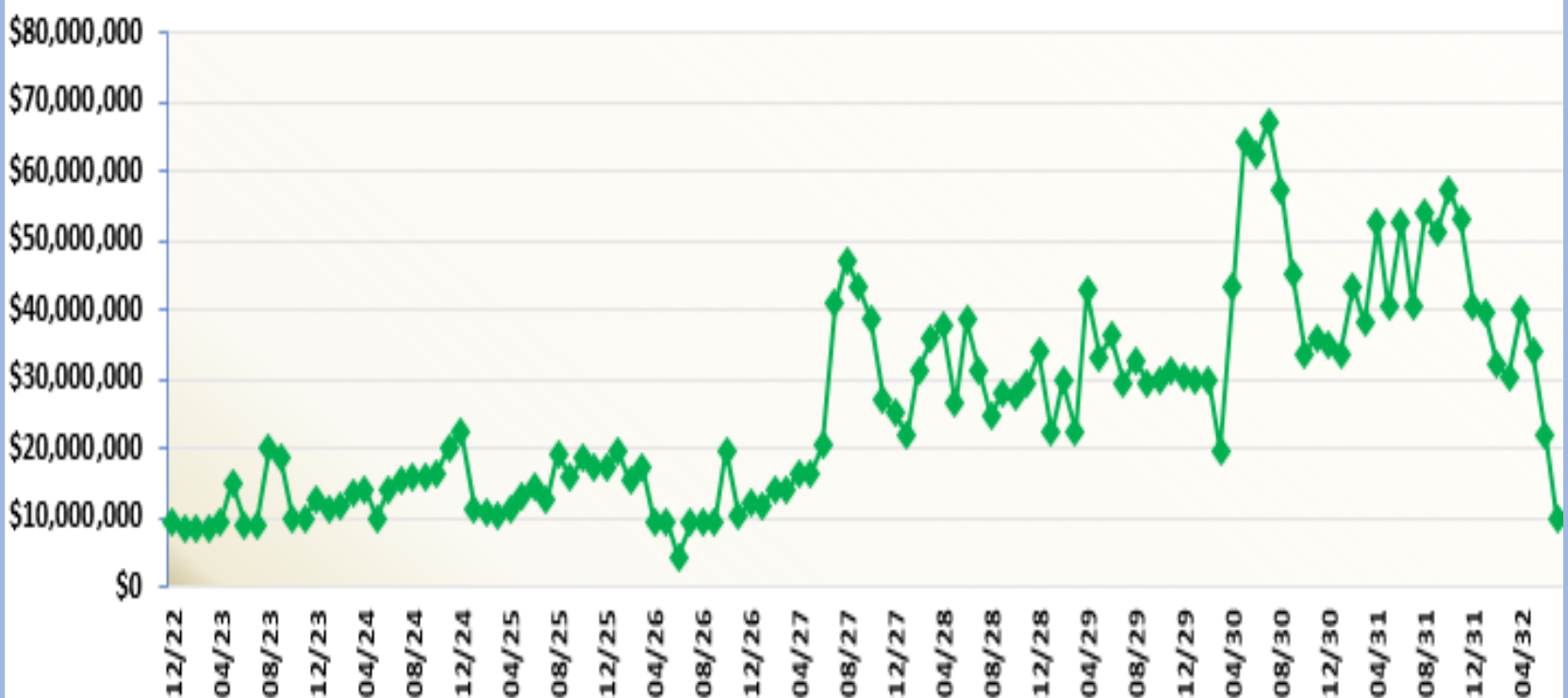

MEMORANDUM

Date: December 5, 2022
Re: Changes to Tax Withholding

This memorandum is to notify you of changes to the Form W-4P and Form W-4R, which are used by participants to elect their federal tax withholding from payments made from a defined benefit or defined contribution pension plan and explain the required action by the Fund.

Summary and Recommended Actions

- For all retirements effective on or after January 1, 2023, the Fund must include the updated Form W-4P or Form W-4R as applicable with its benefit applications. (Enclosed.) For pending retirements that are in process, the updated Form W-4P or Form W-4R should be sent now, so that the election can be made as part of the retirement process.
- For all participants who are retiring on and after January 1, 2023 and who fail to complete and return the new Form W-4P with an election, the Fund must withhold based on “single or married filing separately”, rather than the current default withholding election of “married with three allowances.” (The default is not changing for those who retired before January 1, 2023.)
- For all participants who retired (retirees) before January 1, 2023 and (1) previously completed the old Form W-4P with an affirmative election or elected a flat dollar withholding or (2) made no election and have the current default withholding of “married with three allowances,” the Fund has two options until a revised tax withholding form is received. One option is to use a formula published by IRS to convert the current withholding election to the new withholding elections. The other option is to use updated withholding tables issued by IRS. We understand that both options are intended to result in similar withholding amounts. Consequently, we recommend that the Fund send the updated forms with an explanatory cover letter to these retirees as soon as possible about their opportunity to change their elected withholdings.

- If a retiree who retired prior to January 1, 2023 elected to have no withholdings, that election will remain unchanged.
- If tax withholdings are calculated automatically through the Fund's computer system, the Fund Office will need to work with its software vendor to confirm that the proper programming is in place to handle these calculations. If not, these conversions will need to be done manually until the systems are updated. The Fund's internal accountant or outside auditor may be able to assist with the conversion formulas.

Overview of Changes

Prior to 2021, the Internal Revenue Service ("IRS") had one tax form for use by participants to elect their federal tax withholdings for all forms of payments made by a defined benefit or defined contribution pension plan – the Form W-4P. The amount withheld from a participant's pension benefit for federal tax purposes was based on the number of allowances claimed and any additional flat dollar amount the participant requested to be withheld. On March 12, 2021, the IRS issued a revised Form W-4P, which split the form into a new Form W-4P and a Form W-4R. Final versions of the new Forms W-4P and W-4R were issued on January 3, 2022 (copies enclosed). Prior to January 1, 2023, use of these new forms was optional. However, under IRS Publication 15-T, for retirements on or after January 1, 2023, use of the new forms are required. Therefore, the Fund should include these new forms with its benefit applications.

Beginning January 1, 2023, the revised Form W-4P is required to be completed by participants who elect to receive retirement benefits in the form of periodic payments (i.e., payments made at regular intervals over the span of more than one year, such as single life annuities and joint and survivor annuities). The new Form W-4R must be completed by participants who elect to receive nonperiodic retirement payments (lump sum payments or installments paid out in less than one year) and eligible rollover distributions.

In addition to requiring separate forms, IRS has made several changes to the federal withholding rates for retirement benefits. For example, instead of selecting a number of allowances, beginning January 1, 2023, a participant's withholding rate will be determined based on filing status for the retiree's federal income tax (single, married filing separately, married filing jointly, etc.), whether they have additional sources of income (such as a second pension benefit or a spouse's pension benefit), and any dependents they claim. Participants also are no longer allowed to elect a flat dollar withholding amount.

If participants do not complete a tax form to make any withholding election, they are subject to a default withholding rate. Prior to January 1, 2023, the default withholding rate for periodic payments is "married claiming three withholding allowances." Beginning January 1, 2023, the default withholding rate is "single or married filing separately." This means that, for participants who retire on or after January 1, 2023 and who do not make an alternative election, they must have federal taxes withheld at the rate for unmarried individuals with no allowances. This will generally result in higher amounts being withheld from monthly pension benefits than under the previous default rule. The rule does not change for participants who retired prior to January 1, 2023 and who did not make an alternative election --- the default withholding rate of "married claiming three withholding allowances" will continue.

For nonperiodic distributions, Plans were required to withhold a minimum of 10% for federal taxes. Starting in 2023, participants completing the new Form W-4R will be permitted to elect a withholding rate of less than 10%, but 10% will remain the default withholding if no alternative election is made.

As noted above, while the Fund is not required to send the updated Form W-4P or Form W-4R to participants who retired before January 1, 2023 and previously completed the old Form W-4P, we recommend that it do so to provide retirees with the option to change their withholding rates. If a retiree who retired prior to January 1, 2023 made an affirmative withholding election, elected a flat dollar withholding, or has a default withholding of “married with three allowances,” the Fund has two options for calculating the retiree’s withholdings until an updated Form W-4P or W-4R is received. First, the Fund may use the formula published by IRS to convert the current withholding election to the new withholding elections. Alternatively, the Fund may use the updated withholding tables issued by IRS. We understand that both options are intended to result in similar withholding amounts. IRS Publication 15-T provides further information regarding these options. If a retiree who retired prior to January 1, 2023 elected to have no withholdings, that election will remain unchanged.

We will continue to keep you updated as further guidance is issued. In the meantime, please contact us with any questions.
