Kaiser Permanente's role in vaccine development, distribution, and monitoring

From the beginning, Kaiser Permanente has been at the forefront of clinical trials seeking to develop safe and effective vaccines to prevent COVID-19. As an approved provider in every market where we operate, Kaiser Permanente administers vaccines to both members and nonmembers, following federal and state guidelines.



Vaccine development

- In March 2020, the National Institutes of Health selected Kaiser Permanente to test the first investigational vaccine against COVID-19. The trials proceeded at record speed.
- We've conducted Phase 3 clinical trials evaluating the safety and efficacy of 3 leading vaccine candidates.



Vaccine distribution

- Kaiser Permanente members have access to vaccines from any state-approved provider.
- We empower care teams with evidence-based guidance to deliver the vaccines and keep our members safe.
- We've launched mass vaccination sites in multiple states to vaccinate larger populations more quickly.



Ongoing monitoring

- As one of the largest research centers in the country, Kaiser Permanente is instrumental in tracking the safety and efficacy of COVID-19 vaccines.
- The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention works with our Vaccine Study Center to help analyze national vaccination data and identify serious reactions.

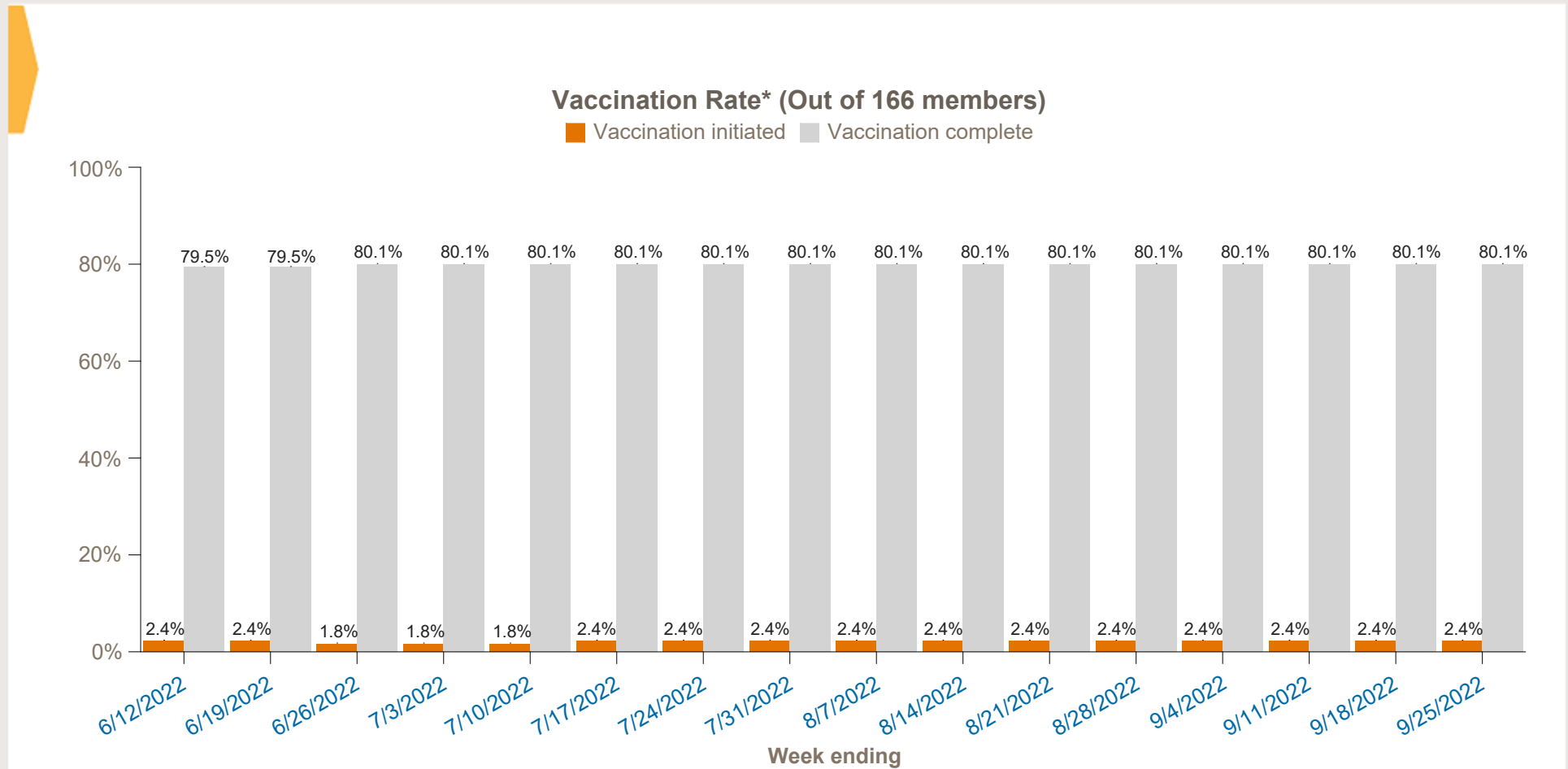

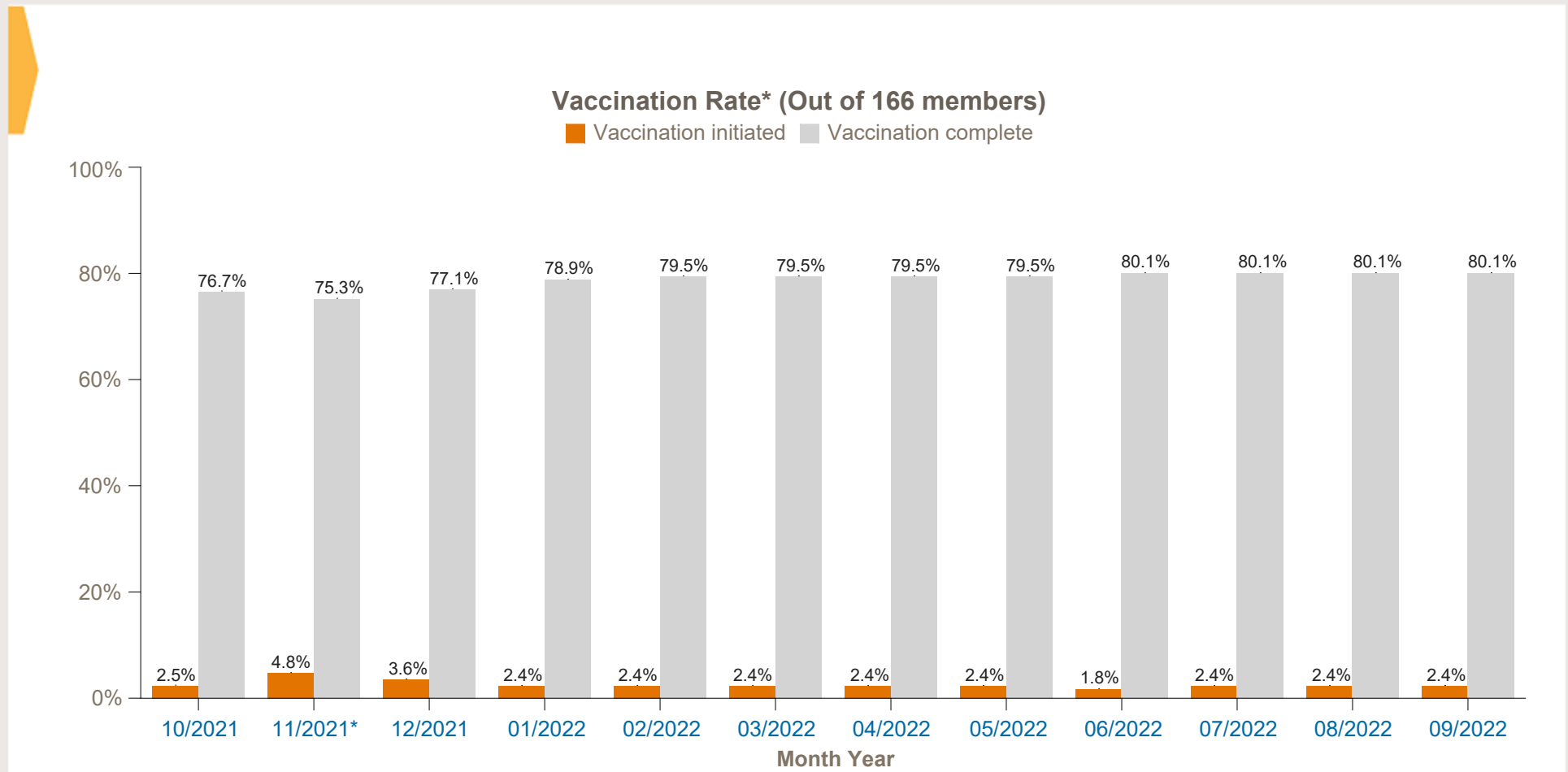
