Reference for service fees

On September 18, 2025, and February 10, 2026, the Administrators sent demand letters in the amount of \$265.04 for the late payment of the July 2025 contributions. On February 6, 2026, counsel for the Funds sent a subsequent demand letter via Certified Mail in the total amount of \$615.04, which included attorney's fees in the amount of \$350.00. **On August 10, 2026, the Administrators confirmed that balance is still outstanding.**

Reference for service fees

On February 5, April 18, May 1, August 30, and October 17, 2024, the Administrators sent demand letters in the total amount of \$352.78 for the late payment of the December 2023, and February, March, June, and August 2024 contributions. On February 13, 2026, counsel for the Funds sent a subsequent demand letter via Certified Mail in the total amount of \$702.59, inclusive of attorney's fees in the amount of \$350.00. On February 17, 2026, the certified mail correspondence was received and the return receipt was signed by Ms. Katie Rosebrugh; however, payment has not been received by the Administrators' office. **On August 10, 2026, the Administrators confirmed that payment has not been received.**

Waivers of service fees per the board policy are allowed if the following requirements have been met: 1) Waivers are not granted automatically. Employers must show they qualify and are eligible for the waiver; 2) The Employer must be current in its contribution payments and must have timely made all other contribution payments within the last 12 months; 3) Waivers may only be granted once in a three (3) year rolling period upon request; 4) Waivers can only be granted for a two (2) month consecutive period within the three-year period; 5) All other fees remain due and

On March 18, 2026, the Administrators sent demand letters in the amount of \$1,325.92 for the late payment of the January 2026 contributions. On April 2, 2026, counsel for the Funds sent a demand letter via Certified Mail in the total amount of \$1,715.92, inclusive of attorney's fees in the amount of \$350.00. **On August 10, 2026, the Administrators confirmed that balance still outstanding.**

REQUESTS FOR WAIVER**Union Temporary Services, Inc.****Service Fees**

The Administrators sent a demand letter on July 6, 2026, in the amount of \$1,195.34 for the late payment of the May 2026 contributions. On July 16, 2026, Union Temporary Services explained that the payment had, for some unexplained reason, arrived late and asked the Administrators to waive the late-payment fees. Fund Counsel reviewed the records and determined that Union Temporary Services, Inc. is eligible for the waiver.

RANDOM SHOP AUDITS

On February 12, 2026, the administrators identified these five employers for random shop audit: 1) Sarens Nuclear & Industrial, 2) Kiewit Business Center, 3) Fuse Equipment, 4) Allied Power, and 5) PCI Energy Services, LLC. Correspondence dated February 20, 2026 was mailed to these employers advising of the payroll audit being conducted by Bellows Associates in accordance with the Agreement and Declaration of Trust and Collection Procedures.
