

I. Apprentices:

- We have added 13 new apprentices, terminated 9, and transferred 2 since our last trustees meeting bringing our total to 109 apprentices.

II. Upgrading Program:

- We have had 52 applicants come in to fill out an application.
- Mike Smith continues to visit contractors to talk about our apprenticeship, training, apprentices, the new mechanics program and pre-apprenticeship program.
- Apprenticeship Policies and Procedures was completed for the apprenticeship training program effective on June 2025. (*See Attachment A.*)
- Mike Smith has been invited to be a member of the Broward Career Source consortium on education and industry. The first meeting was held on May 28, 2025.
- Mike Smith attended the:
 - FAC 66th Annual Conference being held in St. Pete Beach, FL on July 14-18, 2025, previously approved by the board.
 - Broward County Building Trades meeting on May 29, 2025.
 - Meeting with Nehlsen Advertisement and representatives from the Union Hall on June 20, 2025. We would like to start working with them to update our brochures, social media and website. (*See Attachment B.*)
 - Junior Achievement Pre Apprentice Program “trade union presentations and hiring fair” on June 27, 2025.

- Mike Smith had an informational meeting with Diesel laptops regarding quotes on grants on June 23, 2025.

- Per the approval of the board:
 - The apprentice mechanic program was initiated on August 2, 2025. We currently have a total of 11 apprentices that are in the program.
 - The pre-apprenticeship program was initiated on August 19, 2025, with 30 pre-apprentices enrolled.
 - Mr. Billy Currier has been hired by the Fund as full-time instructor as of June 27, 2025. We would like to purchase a work truck for him. (*See Attachment C – Estimate*)
- We have received our approval letter for the mechanic standards program from the Florida Department of Education. (*See Attachment D.*)
- Mike Smith continues to go to PCJAC and UJAC meetings. The apprenticeship will send copies of the documents from those meetings to Associated Administrators as requested.
- Per the approval of the Board at the May meeting,
- .10 an hour is going into the apprenticeship training program after the crane rental contract negotiations were completed.
- We will request approval to:
 - Attend the Mid-Winter planning session for the 2026 FAC Conference at the Ocean Reef on December 11-13, 2025. (*See Attachment E.*)

- Attend the 2026 Institute for Apprenticeship Training & Education Programs which will be held in San Juan, PR on January 12-14, 2026. He would also like for the new instructor Billy Currier to also attend. (See *Attachment F.*)

VI. Training Site:

- We have had 6 members use our facility to take their NCCCO OPT (online proctor testing) written exams.
